




EXPENSE ALLOCATION BY PORTFOLIO







PORTFOLIO BUDGET ALLOCATION (ABS VALUE)






























Budget Allocation

- Community engagement is to be promoted given significant allocation to the Student Life portfolio.

Responsible Spending

- 2022-23 spending requires us to significantly pull back this year (~26% decrease from last year's expenses).
- The Gala venue should be chosen with more financial consideration.
- Future VSEUS teams financial independence must be considered we do not want to leave them in a similar financial bind.
